# Pilot for Early Recovery and Livelihoods (PEARL) Program





## **PEARL**

is a GC initiative that **integrates** economic recovery and market systems (ERMS) programming alongside its portfolio of humanitarian assistance (HA) and sustainable development (SD) programming **to test the feasibility and effectiveness** of livelihoods support activities in communities impacted by the war in Ukraine.

The project is funded with **internal GC resources** and targets small businesses, damaged or disrupted by the war, and/or new businesses which can demonstrate ability to create jobs and positively impact the local economy through the establishment of their proposed business.

#### **Objectives:**

- Creating new or reviving lost jobs
- Increasing the number of new businesses:
- Scaling up/expanding existing business activities.

GC has already supported **21 businesses** in war-affected communities **in Chernihiv Oblast**, and **22 businesses in Chernivtsi Oblast**.
